- Responsible to research and recommend major equipment, chemical, and input purchases. Authorized to make minor
 operational input purchases for the unit based on good judgment.
- Ensures timeliness of all cultural practices on the unit, including land preparations, seedbed preparation, planting, cultivating, chemical and fertilizer application, irrigation, and harvesting.
- Accountable for legal and safe application and documentation of chemicals, fertilizers, and pesticides.
- Assists Area Manager in developing capital and operating plans and budgets for the unit and ensures adherence to those plans.
- Participates as a team player and performs farm-wide responsibilities as assigned.
- Other company-wide or farm tasks as directed by Area Manager or company management.

- B.S. degree in Agronomy or related degree or noted equivalent work experience.
- Two to five years potato production experience highly desirable
